Award(s):	A performance as featured soloist with the Bismarck-Mandan Symphony Orchestra on Saturday, April 17, 2021 and a cash prize of \$500. Winner will perform one vocal selection (opera aria or other as deemed appropriate) with the BMSO. Additional non-cash / acknowledgement awards may be determined at the judges' discretion.

Eligibility:	Age requirement as noted above Currently enrolled in a North Dakota college/university in 2020-21 The winner of the Vocal Division competition will perform with the Bismarck-Mandan Symphony Orchestra at its concert on Saturday, April 17, 2021 at the Belle Mehus Auditorium in Bismarck. The winner must be available for one rehearsal prior to the performance date: the evening of Friday, April 16. Formal concert attire is required. Travel to and accommodation in Bismarck is at the expense of the artist. Past vocal division winners are ineligible.
Repertoire:	 Vocal Applicants should perform one selection (opera aria, art song) from the standard repertoire. Orchestral accompaniment must be available for the work. <i>The Bismarck-Mandan Symphony reserves</i> <i>the right to refuse a selection based on its cost or availability. Please call prior to submitting recording</i> <i>to confirm if you wish to compete with <u>anything composed after 1900</u>.</i> The vocal selection must be memorized if invited to the Finals in Bismarck. Maximum length of the selection should not exceed 10 minutes. Minimum length is 4 minutes. After the entry has been received, repertoire changes will not be permitted without the approval of the Music Director of the Bismarck-Mandan Symphony. Contestants must provide their own accompanist. A list of Bismarck-area accompanists is available upon request.
Application Fee:	A \$25 <u>non-refundable</u> application fee must submitted with preliminary recording and completed application.
Judging Decision:	The winner will be announced following the final auditions. All judges' decisions are final.
